NOTE:

- Activation will require both the IMEI of the equipment and the ICCID of the SIM card.
- SIM CANNOT BE MOVED between terminals.
- The service can be activated with up to a maximum of 2 voice lines. These are standard postpay only, there is no prepay scratch card option.
- Monthly subscription charges are prorated in the month on activation, are charged in advance and will be charged a full billing month on deactivations regardless of what date in the month the service is deactivated.
- If an activation is made in the middle of a calendar month both, subscription and allowance, are prorated.
- Iridium will re-rate the pricing for any Land based terminals used as Maritime and vice versa. We will flow this down to the terminal owner.
- There is NO rollover of unused data.
- A service can be UPGRADED at any time or in line with the next billing period. A new minimum period will apply once upgraded. For MID-MONTH upgrades, the initial packages will remain chargeable, and the new subscription and allowance will be prorated.
- An Early Termination Fee (ETF) will apply if the service is deactivated or downgrades before completing the minimum contract period.
